



How to Change Your “Home” Page 03/2004

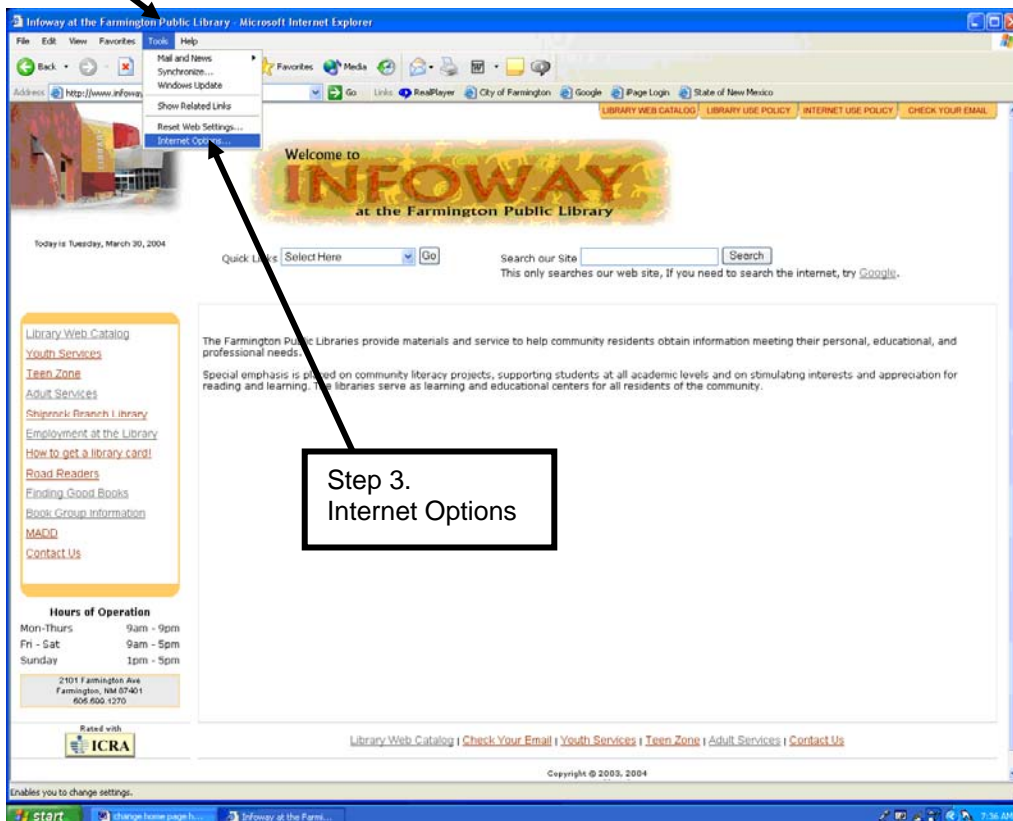
Connect to the Internet and open your Web browser. (In the illustration below, Internet Explorer is used.)

Go to the Web page that you want to set as your “home” page.

In the menu bar, click once on **Tools** to see the drop-down menu. Highlight and click on **Internet Options**.

Click on the tab **General**, to display the window shown below.

The upper portion of this window allows you to set your “home” page. Click on the button **Use Current**. Notice that the address box now displays the URL (Uniform Resource Locator, or Web address) of the page being displayed.

Click on the button **OK**, toward the bottom of the window. Your “home” page has now been reset. This means that each time you open your Web browser, or click on the Home button, the Web page you selected will be displayed.
