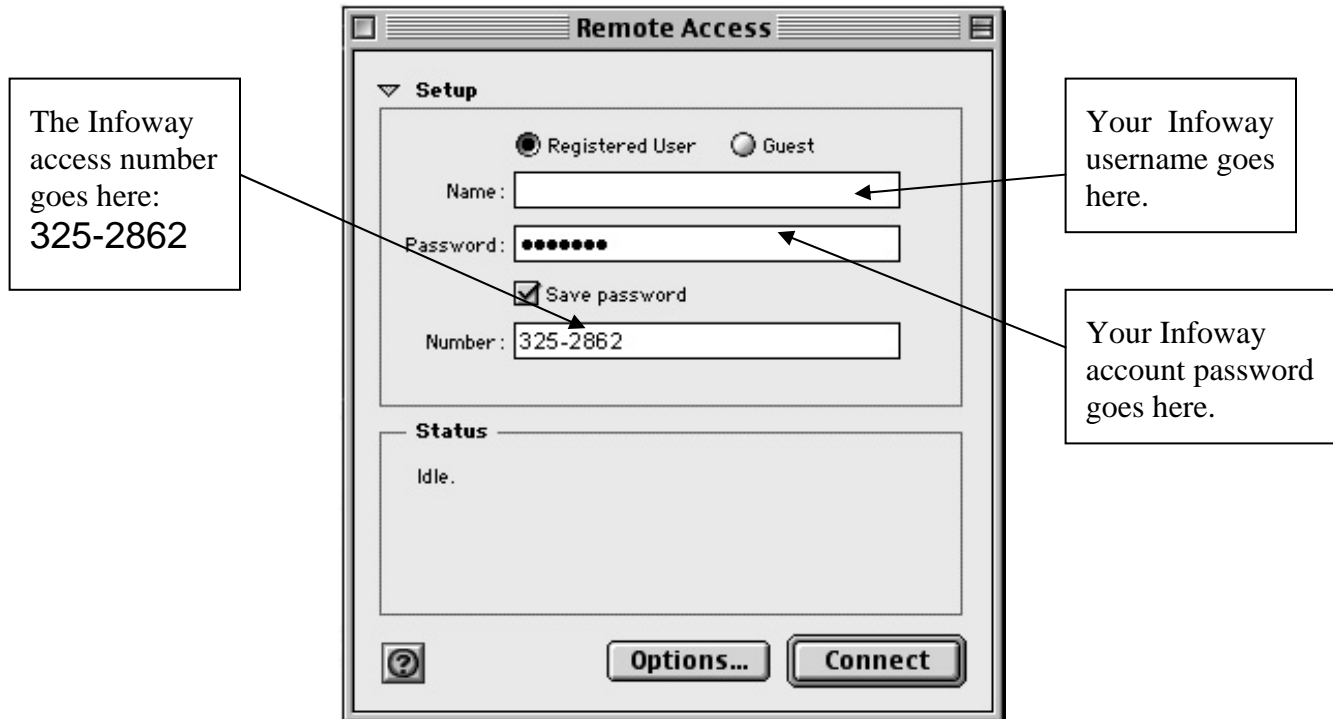


How to Connect Your Mac to Infoway 10/2001

Remote Access Setup

1) Click on the "Apple" menu in the upper left hand corner. Pull down to "Control Panels" and select "Remote Access".

2) The box shown below will appear. Make sure that Registered User circle is selected as shown below.



3) Now you need to enter your username and password. Type your username into the "Name" box and type your password into the "Password" box. Type the phone number into the "Number" box. Use 325-2862 for Infoway.

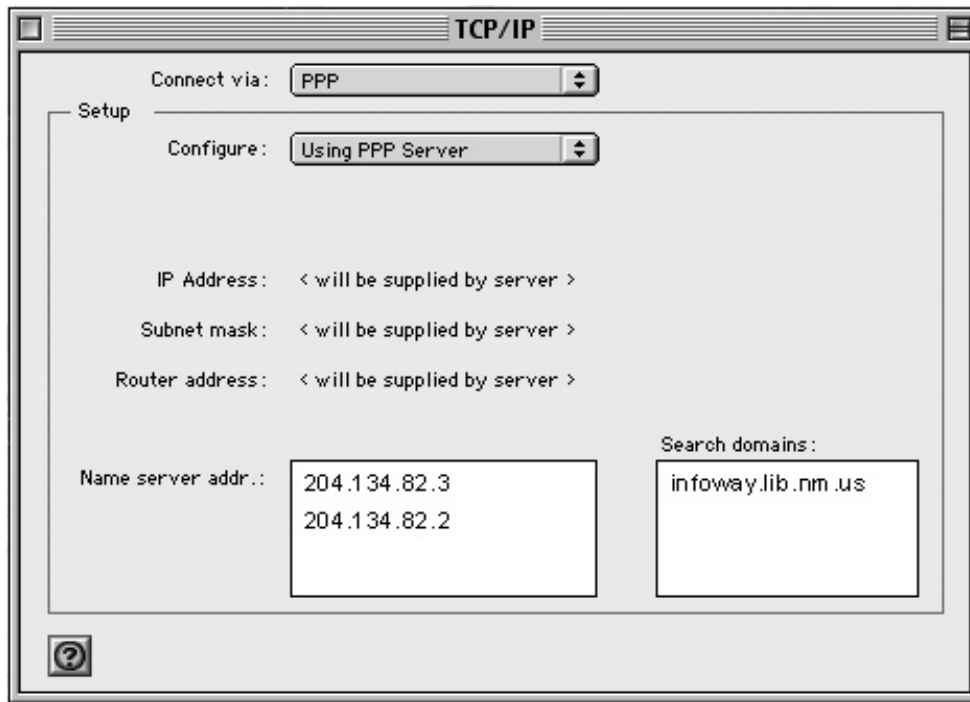
4) Close the "Remote Access" Control Panel by clicking on the box in the upper left-hand corner.

5) A window will appear asking you if you want to save the changes you made. Click "Save".

TCP/IP Setup

1) Click on the "Apple" menu in the upper left-hand corner. Pull down to "Control Panels" and select "TCP/IP".

2) The box shown below will appear. Make sure that "**Connect via:**" is set to "PPP" (as shown below) and that "**Configure:**" is set to "Using PPP Server" (as shown below).



3) Now you need to enter some information into the "Name server addr" box and the "Search domains" box.

In the "Name server addr" box, type: (Ignore Numbers in Picture Above)

198.243.13.3

198.243.13.2

In the "Search domains" box, type:

infoway.lib.nm.us

4) Close the "TCP/IP" Control Panel by clicking on the box in the upper left-hand corner.

5) A window will appear asking you if you want to save the changes you made. Click "Save".

Your PPP Connection is now complete, and gives your computer the ability to access the Internet through a dial-up line. In order to use the Internet your computer must have a Web browser (such as Internet Explorer or Netscape Navigator) in order to browse the World Wide Web.
