# FOUR CORNERS STORYTELLING FESTIVAL

October 9, 10 & 11, 2008

## REGISTRATION

This year we have added an extra day on Thursday, October 9th that is reserved especially for field trips. Space is still limited, and reservations will be made on a first come, first served basis. Please register early for this event. If space is filled, your school may be placed on a waiting list and will be notified in order if space becomes available. Sessions for the Thursday, Friday and Saturday field trip days are \$5 for per person for a day of storytelling from 9:00 am to approximately 4:00 pm at Berg Park. Youth storytellers from New Mexico and around the Four Corners host Field Trip Days.

Payment for the festival should be received before Wednesday, October 1, 2008. Purchase Orders can be made out to Farmington Public Library FCSF. Credit cards are also accepted. All reservations will be held until October 1, and then they will be released to schools that are on the waiting list. Payment and Purchase Orders that will be delivered to the festival must be pre-approved by Sondra Rouse by calling 566-2335 before October 1st, 2008.

All tickets will be waiting at the festival registration table. Please arrive early in order to allow time to pick up your tickets. No tickets will be distributed before the event.

## EVENT

Dress appropriately for the weather. The festival is an outdoor tent event at Berg Park. There will be 3-4 tents set up and your students will be walking from tent to tent to see various youth and professional storytellers. Seating will be provided in each of the tents.

## SCHEDULE

Brochures containing teller information and the schedule for Friday and Saturday are available at the Farmington Public Library. A detailed schedule for Youth Storytelling will be available in September.

## TENT ETTIQUETTE

In consideration of others, it is imperative that your group arrives on time, and does not leave during any of the storytelling sessions. Tent monitors will be checking for tickets at each session, and will not be allowing any groups into the tent after a storytelling session has begun. Any groups that are disruptive will be asked to leave and will not be issued a refund. Seating in each tent is available on a first come, first served basis.

## FOOD

There will be a break from 12:00 to 12:30 pm for lunch. Students may bring sack lunches, and some food will be available. Drinking water fountains are available throughout Berg Park. All groups are expected to clean up after themselves.

## OTHER FEATURES

There will be a bookstore open during the festival on Friday and Saturday. You may purchase books and CDs of the storytellers, and other storytelling merchandise. If you would like to hire a storyteller to perform for your school or organization, please see the bookstore for more information. There is one restroom at Berg Park. Porta-potties will be available at the east end of the festival grounds, near the entrance.
